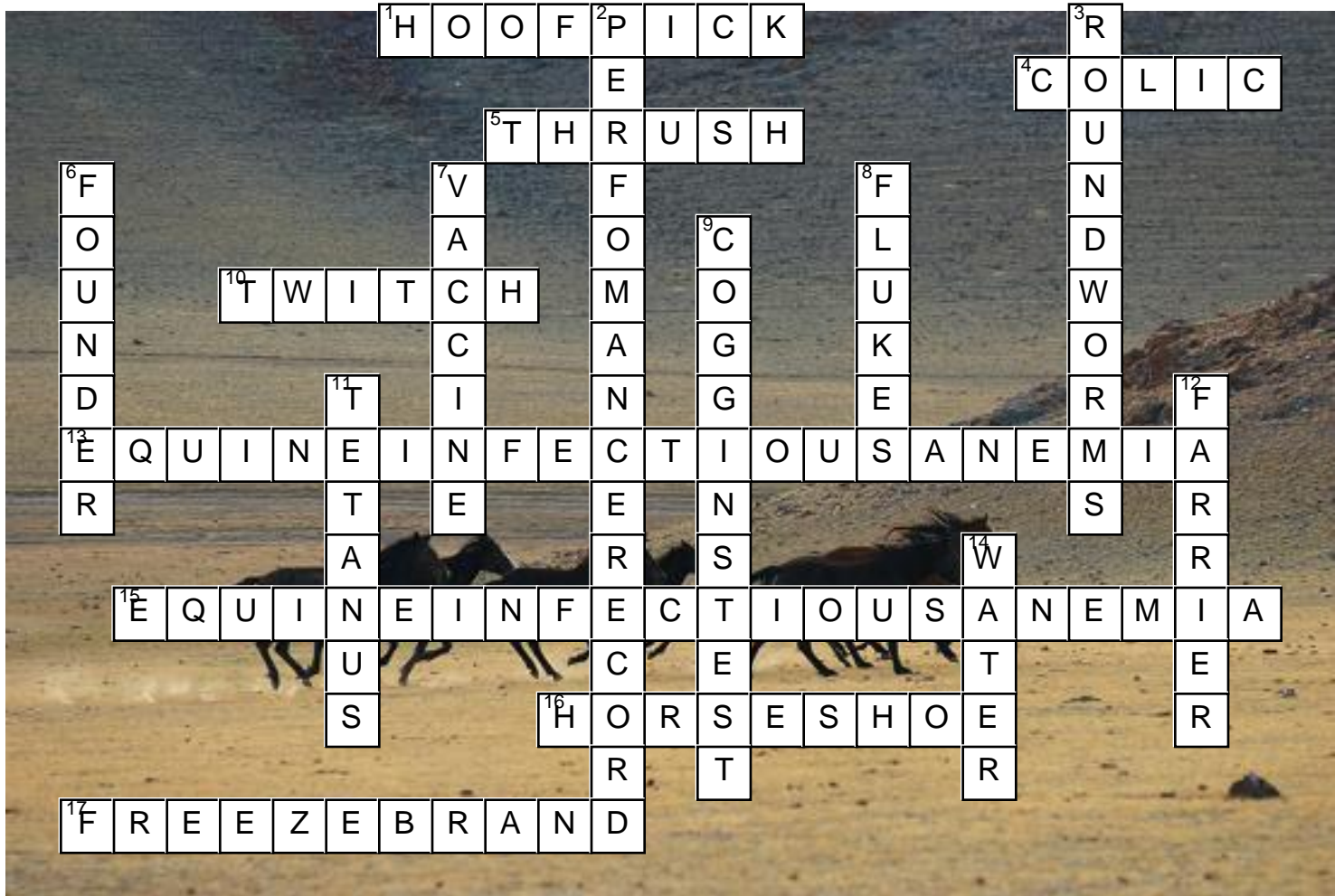


Equine Management

4. Abdominal pain exhibited by horses; can be extremely serious [COLIC]
5. Inflammation of the fleshy frog of the foot caused by fungus [THRUSH]

13. EIA [EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA]
15. Viral disease, without a cure; infected horses must be permanently quarantined or destroyed [EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA]
16. U-shaped item made of metal attached to the horses hoof [HORSESHOE]
17. An identifying mark made with a "brand" that is cooled in liquid nitrogen or dry ice [FREEZE BRAND]
